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Board MLM Plan (Matrix Cycle Plan)



The Board MLM Plan, also known as the Matrix Cycle Plan, is a popular MLM compensation model where distributors are organized into a matrix, often called a board. Each distributor fills spots in the matrix by recruiting new members, moving through different stages (or "boards") to earn commissions.

How the Board MLM Plan Works

The most common format is a 2×2 board, where:

- Each distributor recruits 2 direct members
- The board is filled with 6 total members (2 on level 1, 4 on level 2)

Step-by-Step Process:

1. Join the Board

A new member joins and gets placed in an empty 2×2 matrix (board).

2 Recruit Members

The member recruits two new people to their first level. Each of those recruits also brings in two members, filling the second level.

3 Complete the Cycle

Once all 6 positions in the matrix are filled, the board "cycles," and the original member moves to a new board or higher-level matrix.



4 Earn Commissions

Upon completing a cycle, the member receives a cycle commission, often double the joining fee.

Types of Commissions in the Board Plan

1. Referral Commission

- What it is: Earned when you directly refer a new member.
- ExaAmple: If your referral joins with a \$100 joining fee, you may earn a \$10-\$20 bonus instantly.

2. Cycle Commission

- What it is: Earned when your 2×2 matrix is fully filled.
- Example: If the company offers a \$100 joining fee and you complete a full matrix, you receive \$200 as your cycle commission.

Bonuses in the Board MLM Plan

1. Leadership Bonus

- What it is: Earned by distributors who reach leadership ranks or complete multiple boards.
- Purpose: Rewards those who build and manage large teams.
- **Example**: Achieving "Board Leader" rank may grant a \$500 bonus.

2. Sponsor Bonus

- What it is: Awarded for personally sponsoring new members into the system.
- Purpose: Encourages continuous recruitment and network expansion.
- Example: You receive \$25 each time your direct recruit completes their first board cycle.



3. Level Bonus

- What it is: Commissions from the activity and sales of downline members in various board levels.
- Purpose: Ensures income even from indirect sales.
- Example: You may earn \$5 per sale made by your team members up to 2 board levels below you.

4. Rank Achievement Bonus

- What it is: Given when a distributor achieves a certain rank or number of completed board cycles.
- Purpose: Motivates long-term commitment and progress.
- Example: Completing 10 boards might earn you a \$1,000 milestone bonus.

Commission Calculation in Board MLM Plan

- Most companies charge a one-time joining fee, for example, \$100.
- After completing your 2×2 matrix (6 members), you're typically paid double, such as \$200.

 - 1. Commission rates
 - 2. Board splitting options
